

# THINGS TO KNOW

## How to Register

- To register online or download our registration form visit [www.ymcaofmewsa.org](http://www.ymcaofmewsa.org). To request a registration form by mail, please call the specific program site. Forms can be returned in person or by mail. Contact information for each site is located in this brochure.
- A \$25 non-refundable deposit is due for each week upon registration.
- After registering you will receive a medical form that must be completed prior to your child attending Y camp. Certain program sites require medical forms to be notarized prior to the start of camp. Please check with your site director.
- Any changes to existing registrations will incur a \$20 fee after May 1, 2017.

## Camp Payments

- Payment Due Dates:
  - Camp Weeks 1-3 due on or before June 1.
  - Camp Weeks 4-6 due on or before July 1.
  - Camp Weeks 7-9 due on or before August 1.
- Payments may be made by credit card draft, bank draft, or by check made out to the YMCA of MEWSA.
- Payments made with the EZ Pay option will be assessed on payment due dates.
- A \$20 fee will be assessed on all late payments.
- There are no credits or refunds for absences.
