NAME OF THEME	WEEK	DESCRIPTION
Baby Shark Week	6/24-6/28	The campers will go Under the Sea with Baby Shark in a fun filled week of Baby Shark songs, finger plays and crafts.
Hooray for the USA	7/1-7/5	Three Cheers for the Red, White and Blue!!! Will be a Stars & Stripe week with activities to include making Patriotic Dancing Rings, Fun with Fireworks playdough and creating hand print flag cards for the Veteran's Home in Edison and more!!!
3-D Art with Recyclables	7/8-7/12	Trash turned Kids crafts! The campers will be creating 3-D art with recyclables – to include using old puzzle pieces, broken crayons, used greeting cards and plastic bottles and paper towel tubes.
Mad Scientist	7/15-7/19	Curious campers will experience 5 days of science fun using their senses- sight, hearing, touch, smell and sometimes even taste. They will explore magnets, what is and what isn't magnetic, explore shadows with animal stick puppets, make homemade slime and visit a five senses science table!!!

Eric Carle's World of Insects & Bugs	8/5-8/9	Eric Carle's World of Insects and Bugs Eric Carle is a beloved author/illustrator of beautiful books for children. We will explore various insects and bugs pictured in his books. The campers will also experience how Eric Carle created the beautiful pictures in his storybooks.
STEAM Week (Science, Technology, Engineering & Music	8/12-8/16	The concepts of science, technology engineering art and math are incorporated into this week's activities. Hands on play with different materials will instill a curiosity in children. A summer kaleidoscope will encourage the sense of sight. They will become engineers creating sculptures using a variety of materials. Art will include painting with magnets and creating a sticky print using salt, watercolors and contact paper.
