READING EXPLORERS 1 Ages 4 (by October 1) - 5

When: Mondays, 1:00-2:30pm • Fee: \$285 (9-week session)

Session Dates: 11/9, 11/16, 11/23, 11/30, 12/7, 12/14, 12/21, 1/4, 1/11

The first of this trimester in-person program, meets once a week and specifically teaches reading readiness skills. The children will review letter sounds and begin to explore long and short vowel sounds and their use in the English language. Students will also learn to properly print letter symbols using correct pencil grip and good posture. Throughout the three trimesters, annual program sight words and sentence structure will be explored using Workbook A and 12 primers of the Handprints early reading program. Support work will be given for home use.

MATH EXPLORERS Ages 4 (by October 1) - 5
