Supplies:

- FABRIC:
 - JOANN
 - <https://www.joann.com/fabric/>
 - Offers curbside pickup or shipping to your home address. They offer large discounts at times for curbside pickup as well.
 - On the website, click on the department dropdown and select "fabric". You will see a black and yellow sign for pre-cut remnants up to 70% off. Most supplies may be bought at JOANN's.

 - They too ship and some stores offer curbside pickup and some even delivery. Check your local store.
- ELASTIC:
 - Elastic is scarce and delivery dates from Amazon and other online retailers are as late as May. Consider using other materials such as bias tape.
