YOUTH DEVELOPMENT - Developing a new generation of changemakers.



1 in 3 children who participated in our enrichment and life-saving programs received financial support.

1,098 campers enjoyed their summer while learning new skills, improving self-esteem and making friends.

62 children in Y childcare had parents who received financial help to cover the costs of a safe, reliable place for their children while they worked.

HEALTHY LIVING - Improving well-being in mind, body, and spirit

959 individuals got back their health, kept diabetes at bay & improved their mental health with our Open Doors Financial Assistance Program.

Over 2,000 seniors come to our Y each year to find connections, stay active and healthy. 22 seniors were helped with financial assistance.

Nearly 2,000 youth learned water safety skills aimed at preventing drowning accidents and saving lives. More than 104 lifeguards trained.



SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY - Inspiring action and creating equitable communities
